

## The process of gifting land to the Sea and Land Trust (SALT) CLG to preserve for nature in perpetuity

- 1. We will meet you at the property that you wish to put in trust with us and take a tour with you.
- 2. A 14 day cooling off period and confirm that your wishes are to conserve and preserve your property before we incur costs with proceeding.
- 3. On your wishes of wanting to proceed, we will consult with our legal advisor.
- 4. A member of Sea and Land Trust will do a basic assessment of your property with conservation goals.
- 5. Our legal advisor will liaise with your solicitor and draw up the necessary paperwork
- 6. When the Legalities are in order, and both donor and Sea and Land Trust are in agreement: transfer occurs.
- 7. A full ecological assessment is completed by an ecologist, conducting wildlife surveys and cataloguing what is on site already. The preservation of existing wildlife is the immediate goal and a management plan is drawn up.
- 8. The land is added to the Land Bank and will be conserved for nature forever.
